This course is concerned with the basic functional skills that are necessary for the basic use of digital devices and online applications. This course provides students with the basic computer skills, which include: the definition of a computer and its components (hardware and software), representation of computer data, and identification of numerical systems (binary systems, octal systems, decimal, and hexadecimal), which leads to the possession of a set of digital capabilities that help them in the use of digital devices, communication of applications, and networks in order to access and manage information in an ideal and useful manner. It also works on how to use computer programming languages to build Internet pages. This course also aims to introduce students to the digital society (what is the digital society and its ethics), digital citizenship, cyber-bullying, cybercrime, artificial intelligence, and cyber security.
