## Two: Course Description

Course description:

Course description:
The Clinical Community Health Nursing course is designed to orient nursing students to the local, national, and international community nursing disciplines, principles and gain a broad perspective of Community Health Nursing (CHN) at the three levels of care (i.e. individual, family, and community). Emphasis will be placed on health status and health care needs of Jordanian population, to develop strategies for health promotion, and illness prevention. Furthermore, the course provides students with opportunities for comprehensive practice in different community health nursing settings under academic supervision, based on a context of primary health care and current models of health promotion. Throughout this course, students will utilize the problem solving approach by the implementation of nursing process in diverse community settings.



## Course Objectives:

- 1) Perform all of the community health nurse roles within the framework of public health nursing functions.
- 2) Identify factors that affect a community health nurse's selection and practice of each role.
- 3) Experience at least four settings in which community health nurses practice.
- 4) Provide a culturally sensitive nursing care to clients with an emphasis on health promotion and health protection.
- 5) Apply transcultural nursing principles in community health nursing practice.
- 6) Examine the community health services provided by the selected health organizations.
- 7) Explore how the structure and functions of community health services affect community health nursing practice.
- 8) Use epidemiologic methods to describe the health status of the selected communities.
- 9) Explain the strategies used for communicable disease control in the selected communities.
- 10) Perform some common roles and functions of school nurses.
- 11) Explore primary, secondary, and tertiary health prevention activities in a work-place setting.
- 12) Provide primary, secondary, and tertiary prevention practices among the older population.
- 13) Provide primary, secondary, and tertiary prevention practices for disabled individuals.
