Two: Course Description

Course description:

The Clinical Community Health Nursing course is designed to orient nursing students to Intensive clinical training course aims to apply all of the skills and knowledge acquired through the nursing program, and to master these skills through critical thinking process and problem solving approach. It prepares the students to be ready and qualified for their future career as registered nurses. Furthermore, this course helps students to become more independent to search for information. Intensive clinical training course



consists of 40 shifts designed for students to spend them in the selected different health care settings.

Course Objectives:

- 1. Develop a plan of nursing care for patients using strategies of critical thinking.
- 2. Develop teaching plans for patients.
- 3. Apply ethical considerations necessary for protecting the patient's rights related to data collection during the health history taking or physical examination.
- 4. Assess the impact of illness on the patient's family and family functioning.
- 5. Demonstrate applying effective coping strategies that help both the patient and the family to adapt during illness.
- 6. Apply transcultural nursing principles, concepts, and theories when providing nursing care to patients.
- 7. Apply the nursing process in the care of the patient with variable health conditions.
- 8. Describe nursing strategies appropriate for promoting self-care through activities of daily living.
- 9. Use assessment parameters appropriate for determining the characteristics and severity of the major symptoms of variable health conditions.



A.Knowledge and Understanding

- 1. Identify nursing diagnosis and develop nursing care plans based on patients' priorities.
- 2. Assess patients' conditions and modify nursing care plans accordingly.

B.Intellectual skills

- 1. Assess patients on admission and collect essential information.
- 2. Document all nursing activities provided to patients based on the principles of recording and reporting as soon as possible after the performance of procedures.

C.Professional skills

Apply various nursing procedures needed for patients such as: installing IV lines, measuring CVP, giving medications, suctioning, wound care, bed bathing, oral hygiene based on prioritized patient's need.

D.Transferable skills

- 1. Verbalize feelings of confidence when dealing with patients in the actual situation.
- 2. Demonstrate an appreciation for the importance of nursing documentation in providing effective communication and qualified nursing care and legal protection.
