The Faculty of Media at Zarqa University was established in the first semester of /2011/2010 as an extension of the journalism department, which was established in September of 2010 in the Faculty of Arts to supply the local and Arab market with professional media competencies to keep pace with technical and scientific developments in the field of communication. The faculty currently includes more than 200 students, in addition to a number of other students who study media courses as an optional university requirement, the faculty has 8 members is of various academic ranks and with a distinguished academic and professional reputation.

Graduating students with scientific and professional qualifications that enable them to keep pace with media developments and provide high-level academic programs characterized by modernity

Carrying the message of knowledge associated with work in the various fields of media to meet the needs of the local, Arab and international labor market and qualifying scientific competencies to serve the labor market and society

Objectives

The faculty seeks to graduate technically qualified media professionals to serve community issues and contribute to achieving sustainable development in the Kingdom. The faculty's objectives are:

- Keeping pace with the technical development related to the media production audio, video and digital systems.
- Keeping Pace with scientific development in the fields of media production and marketing
- Training students on how to use technical devices to develop their media and technical skills
- Providing a positive environment that stimulates creativity and develops personal abilities and skills
- Assisting students in obtaining appropriate training in a multi-media institution
- The dissemination of knowledge by strengthening scientific research cooperation with local, Arab and international scientific institutions

Faculty departments

1- Department of Journalism and Digital Media

The Department of Journalism and Digital Media is an extension of the Department of Journalism and Media, which began receiving students in 2010. The department's name was changed at the beginning of the first semester 2020 2021 to keep pace with developments in the field of digital media, as the specialization includes multiple fields of knowledge in journalism, radio, television, digital media and communication

The department currently includes more than 100 students, and the Arabic language is used as the main language of instruction. Practical and applied training occupies a large part of the study plan with the aim of refining students' skills and qualifying them to compete in the labor market

2- Radio and Television Department

The department began receiving students at the beginning of the first semester of the 2015-2016 academic year. The number of students is about 100 students, and Arabic is the main language. The teaching plan includes specialized courses, practical and applied training occupies a large part of it, such as operating the radio and television studios of the faculty in order to refine Students' skills and qualifications in the labor market

Faculty's facilities

The faculty includes television and radio studios operated by students as broadcasters, presenters, and producers, in addition to three modern laboratories to train students in journalistic, editing and news directing, in addition to hosting a radio and television Leqaa. The college organized in 2018 the Media Creativity Forum, the first of its kind at the level of media faculties in Jordan to enhance cooperation between faculties and to develop students' technical and professional skills to compete for forum awards

Scientific research and community service

The college pays great attention to scientific research, as three scientific conferences were held at the university campus, represented by the first international conference entitled "Awareness Media discourse between Sharia and Law" in 2015, the second international conference entitled "The Role of Sharia, Law and Media in Combating Terrorism" in 2016 and the third international conference entitled "Media between hate speech and intellectual security" in 2017, in addition to the participation of faculty members in regional and international scientific conferences. Currently, the faculty seeks to host the international conference of the Arab American Association of Communication Professors

Cooperation agreements

The faculty signed many cooperation agreements in the fields of student training with the Radio and Television Corporation, the Jordan News Agency, and the Jordanian Media Institutes, the International Media Support Organization, , and Al-Mamlaka TV, while the faculty is working to conclude training agreements with other media institutions to expand the scope of field training requested by it.
